# 1. SIERRA LEONE

Where it all began in 2008

- 2008: a group of 100 street children in Makeni
- 2009: Expansion to a more effective model across the country
- Education to the country's most remote areas
- 2014: Ebola: emergency support & 12.000 orphans
- 2017: Emergency support following the Freetown mudslide
- 2018: Started ambitious plan of building 1000 Schools  
Already 333 built!



## 2. LIBERIA

Since 2013, following our work in Sierra Leone Liberia is projected to be one of world's last countries to get education.

- Similar work to Sierra Leone, including Ebola emergency support and Girls Speak Out
- Government program: Partnership Schools for Liberia - 24 schools supported with Teacher Training, Parent-teacher involvement, Reading Program, Principal's Management





### 3. NEPAL

Since 2015, following the earthquakes

- Constructed: Learning Centers + WASH facilities (toilets, wells, sanitary equipment)
- Trained 194 teachers
- Bringing education to Brick factories: 6 built already and 5 more on the way
- Since April 2018: Empowering the most marginalized, the Musahar caste





## 4. NIGERIA

Since 2016, following the conflict with Boko Haram:

- A. Education in Emergencies: there is a potential lost generation
- B. Unaccompanied and separated children in Borno State
  - Street Child's Approach
    - Family Tracing and Reunification
    - Education → Building Temporary Learning Centers and training community teachers
    - Livelihoods → Family Business Scheme, following training by the Sierra Leone team
  - Training the government on education in emergency & child protection
